Clerk Report:

In April the Town took in \$300; \$200 in Transfer Station permits, \$70 in Building Permits, and \$30 in Sporting Licenses. It was disbursed; \$28.34 to the DEC and \$271.66 to the Supervisor.

Code Enforcement:

John Furlong reported 2 inspections and 2 new permits, one for a septic repair and one addition to an existing home.

The Supervisor and Bookkeeper's reports were submitted. No Assessor's report, but Grievance Day will be on June 5, 3 to 5 and 6 to 8 PM.

Highway, Building and Grounds:

The CHIPS, EWR, Pave NY, and POP budgets are out for this year. The Town has the following balances available: CHIPS- \$96,331.32, Pave NY- \$22,350.35, EWR- \$19,408.65, and POP- \$25,194.61 (\$10,294.38 rollover balance).

Supervisor Howard informed the Board that, after speaking with the Caroga Lake Fire Department Chief, it seems that they have not set the boundaries for the new Fire District yet, so it will be a while before there is a vote.
