Clerk Report:

The Supervisor, Bookkeeper, and Assessor's reports were submitted.

Supervisor Howard gave an overview of the County Budget. The biggest problem is that the State is not passing through Federal money intended for the County, the County must pay \$273,000 per week for Medicaid from the local tax levy.

Per advice from our attorney, the Town is submitting the bill for our plow truck repair to NYMIR, they may be able to cover it. They will send an adjuster out to look at the truck.

Supervisor Howard also reported that we should get our CHIPS money in December.
