# BLEECKER PROGRAM GUIDELINES

## UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Household Hazardous Waste	Motor Oil	Recyclables
Liquid Waste	Paint	Vehicle Batteries
Propane Tanks	Weekly Trash	Gasoline Tanks

- Residents only.
- Tires must be off the rim - pile them separately for recycling. Limit of 4 per person per day. Municipality must haul them directly to DSW. DSW will charge by weight.
- No motor oil, vehicle batteries or paint.
- \$50 per ton charge to the municipality.
- Department of Solid Waste will provide roll-off containers.
- Municipality must provide supervision and bucket loader if necessary.
- Department of Solid Waste cannot exchange containers over the weekend, as no staff is available. Please call weekdays between the hours of 7 a.m. and 1 p.m. for container exchanges.
- Acceptable items: furniture, junk, attic and basement cleanup projects, home improvement materials such as lumber, shingles, siding.
- Bulky metals must be placed in separate open top, no garbage with metals. All metals are to be handled by the DSW.
- Refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers and air conditioners containing Freon must be placed separately. (\$5.00 each for Freon Units)
- Electronics will be accepted for recycling. Please keep them separated to prevent breakage, and place them in the electronics truck.
